hint: Look for the preposition which belongs to the verb and you know which "wo compound" you need.

3.)	Wir suchen <i>nach</i> dem Tisch. (We are looking for the table.)	<u>sucht ihr?</u> (What are you looking for?)
4.)	Ich erinnere mich <i>an</i> seinen Namen. (I remember his name.)	 (What do you remember?)
5.)	Er hat Angst <i>vor</i> Schlangen. (He is afraid of snakes.)	 (What is he afraid of?)
6.)	Ich ärgere mich <i>über</i> das Wetter. (I'm annoyed about the weather.)	 (What are you annoyed about?)
7.)	Sie dankt ihm <i>für</i> die Blumen. (She thanks him for the flowers.)	 (What does she thank him for?)
8.)	Wir sprechen <i>über</i> die Vergangenheit. (We are talking about the past.)	 <u>ihr?</u> (What are we talking about?)
9.)	Sie glaubt <i>an</i> Gott. (She believes in God.)	 (What does she believe in?)
10.)	Ich lache <i>über</i> den guten Witz. (I'm laughing about the good joke.)	<u>Worüber du?</u> (What are you laughing about?)



2.) Answer the question in German. To make it a bit easier I have already given you a possible answer in English but you can put in an answer of your own.

	question	answer
1.)	Wofür interessierst du dich? (What are you interested in?)	<u>Ich interessiere mich für Sport.</u> (I'm interested in sports.)
2.)	Wonach suchst du? (What are you looking for?)	<u>Ich suche nach meinen Büchern.</u> (I'm looking for my books.)
3.)	Wovon träumst du? (What do you dream about?)	<u>Ich ...</u> [I dream about a beach (= Strand, male).]
4.)	Woran erinnert ihr euch? (What do you remember?)	<u>Wir ...</u> (We remember the restaurant.)
5.)	Worauf konzentrierst du dich? (What are you concentrating on?)	 (I'm concentrating on my homework.)
6.)	Worüber diskutiert ihr?	 (We are discussing a new topic.)
7.)	Wovor haben sie (=they) Angst?	 [They are afraid of dogs (=Hunde).]
8.)	Worauf wartest du?	 (I'm waiting for the bus.)
9.)	Woran denkst du?	 (I'm thinking of ice cream.)
10.)	Worum geht es? *	 [It's about jealousy (=Eifersucht).]

* We haven't spoken about the expression "gehen um" yet. It's very often used. If you ask "Worum geht es?" you want to know: *What's the matter? / What's the topic? / What's the story?*
