2.)	Wonach suchst du? (What are you looking for?)	<b>Ich suche nach meinen Büchern.</b> (I'm looking for my books.)
3.)	Wovon träumst du? (What do you dream about?)	<b>Ich ...</b> [I dream about a beach (= Strand, male).]
4.)	Woran erinnert ihr euch? (What do you remember?)	<b>Wir ...</b> (We remember the restaurant.)
5.)	Worauf konzentriest du dich? (What do you concentrate on?)	 (I concentrate on my homework.)
6.)	Worüber diskutiert ihr?	 (We discuss about a new topic.)
7.)	Wovor haben sie (=they) Angst?	 [They are afraid of dogs (=Hunde).]
8.)	Worauf wartest du?	 (I'm waiting for the bus.)
9.)	Woran denkst du?	 (I'm thinking of ice cream.)
10.)	Worum geht es? *	 [The matter is jealousy (=Eifersucht).]

\* We haven't spoken about the expression "gehen um" yet. It's very often used. If you ask "Worum geht es?" you want to know: *What's the matter? / What's the topic? / What's the story?*
